PARIS JACKSON THE HIP-HOP JUGGLER


Paris, given the nickname "The Hip Hop Juggler" by Al Roker himself, has been dazzling audiences with his brand of juggling for over a decade.



MONITORS:

Stage Left Stage Right

MICROPHONES:

- 3 Lavalier or Headset Mics
- 2 Handled Mic (On Adjustable Stands)
- 1 Wireless Mic (On Boom stand)
- 1 Mixer Board (4 Channel Minimum) on table Stage right.
- 2 DI Boxes

VISUAL:

- 1 Projector and Projector Screen
- 1 HDMI Connection /Input for Projector Screen (We will be using a Mac Computer)

LIGHTING:

- 1 Overhead Pin Spot Center Stage
- 1 Pin Spot & operator (If Available) Red, Blue Wash
